#### Restricted and Unrestricted

### PAVERS

The Haake Celebration Terrace, established in 2011, is a wonderful way to celebrate a milestone, recognize someone special, or pay tribute to a loved one. The Terrace is located in the Learning Arboretum—an area seen by most visitors—located to the north of the Amphitheatre and Margaret's Pond. Create a personalized message which will be inscribed on the paver.

### BENCHES
