The retreat is designed to bring together groups of high school-aged student leaders – and their faculty advisers – from NCGS schools across North America to share ideas and hone their leadership skills in one of the most inspiring destinations on earth.

Participants will take advantage of all the outdoors has to offer and will learn through hands-on experience with facilitators and expert guides. In addition to the important character-building aspects of student travel, the girls will engage in a range of team building activities and collaborative work.
