A volunteer legislative coordinator who can advise the Board on a course of action from time to time or who already has contacts with the County Council or County Executive Branch can be extremely effective and helpful. Legislation can be tracked using a variety of websites and a report can be submitted on an ongoing basis to the CM Board of Directors by using Microsoft Excel or another software product.
