She will perform at Carnegie Hall in February 2015 with the *Honors Choir* as an Alto 1. Participation in one of the three *Honors* Ensembles is limited to the highest rated high school performers from across North America and selected schools internationally.

Ashlie auditioned this fall for the *Honors Performance Series* and was accepted after a review by the *Honors* Selection Board. Ashlie_studies voice lessons with R.L. Rowsey and piano with Leigh Heward at the Sun Valley School of Music and is a member of Enchante and Carmina Montis at Wood River High School. Additionally, she is actively participating in Noyana, an all-girl community quintet and participated in the Brigham Young University Young Musician Summer Fest for two consecutive years. In 2012-13, Ashlie was awarded the Wood River High School Carmina Montis Tenacity Award and in 2013-14, she was chosen to participate in Idaho All-State Honor Choir. For the past two years, Ashlie has also been the recipient of the Sun Valley Center for the Arts scholarship. Music has allowed her to participate in the Bugsy Malone and Snoopy musical productions as the lead female characters. Some of Ashlie's vocal solo performances include the Wood River High School Talent Show and the 2014 Sun Valley Summer Music Workshop Solo Recital. She has also performed a piano solo in the Sun Valley School of Music Honors Recital. Ashlie has recently joined the Wood River Community Orchestra as the only oboist as well.

Finalists will come together for five days in February 2015 in New York City to have the opportunity to learn from Dr. Eph Ehly work with other Finalists, and get a taste of New York City. The Sunday, February 22, performance is open to the public and specially invited representatives from collegiate music programs.
