PHILOSOPHY OF CARE

This simple statement tells patients what they can expect when they meet with you. Below are some examples of the different categories:

EXPERIENCE

Example: Dr. Joe Smith is a fellowship trained orthopedic surgeon specializing in minimally invasive knee replacement using computer-assisted navigation. He has been in practice since 2005, and has performed more than 300 minimally invasive knee replacements. Dr. Smith treats patients with knee trauma or chronic knee pain. He is the Medical Director of the EvergreenHealth Orthopedic Program, and serves as a Clinical Professor in the Department of Surgery at the University of Washington School of Medicine.

Example: Dr. Jane Smith has been practicing obstetrics and gynecology since 2000 and has delivered more than 900 babies. Dr. Smith's practice includes both low- and high-risk, family-centered obstetrics. She also provides the full range of gynecologic care and treatments, including minimally invasive office procedures and pelvic reconstruction surgeries.

PHILOSOPHY OF CARE

Example: My role is to be your partner and advocate for your health. We'll explore all of the options available for treatment so you can make an informed decision that's right for your needs.

Example: I'm your healthcare partner; I won't tell you what to do, but I will work with you to understand the available options so we can make the best decision together. I will take the time to understand you so my care can be personalized, compassionate and delivered in a truthful and understanding manner.

Example: The patient always comes first. My goal is to treat the patient's knee pain and return them to the activities they enjoy as soon as possible. We will first explore nonsurgical treatments to alleviate the pain. If those are not effective, then we will look at surgical options to improve the patient's quality of life.

PERSONAL INFORMATION

Example: My father and grandfather were both primary care doctors, so I guess it was only natural that I'd follow them into medicine. I decided to go into orthopedics because I love the idea of helping people solve the problems that are keeping them from enjoying life. I enjoy living in this area because of all of the activities available; my husband, our two sons and I love hiking and camping together. We also enjoy all kinds of sports, and I serve as the on-site medical support for Redmond High School football games.

Example: I've always wanted to be a doctor, and my primary care practice has enabled me to be a part of the lives of so many amazing people. My wife and I raised three children, and we now enjoy being grandparents. In our free time, we like to spend time working in the garden and discovering new places to eat. We still find time for an occasional round of golf with friends, and also volunteer at the Homeward Pet animal shelter.
