NOTICE OF RACE October 25-26, 2014

Organizing Authority: Bahia Corinthian Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 1.3 CFJ, Sabot A and Sabot B fleet boats are required to carry weights if under the minimum weight requirement and may be subject to on-water equipment inspection upon the finish of each race. Refer to INSA/CFJ class rules for a list of required equipment.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all junior age CFJ, Laser, Laser Radial, Sabot A, B, C1, C2, C3 sailors.
- 2.2 Skipper must be a member in good standing of INSA, Laser, or the CFJ Class Association.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online at www.bcy.org (Juniors page) on or before 10/20/14 at 11:59pm PDT to receive the early entry discount. **Advanced registration is greatly appreciated.**

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 3.1 Mandatory check-in for all competitors will be open Saturday 10/25/14 from 0830 until 1000 in the Banquet Room at BCYC.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available online on Saturday 10/25/14 and upon check-in at BCYC.

5. RACING VENUE AND COURSES

- 5.1 Ocean Venue: CFJ, Laser, and Laser Radial boats will sail in the vicinity of the Balboa Pier.
- 5.2 Bay Venue: Sabot A, B, C1, C2 and C3 boats will sail in the vicinity of "Five Points" (turning basin).
- 5.3 Courses may be a windward/leeward or any variation of a triangle course. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Three (3) races must be completed to constitute a series.

- 6.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of his/her race scores. This changes RRS A2.
- 6.3 The Corinthian Cup perpetual trophy will be awarded to the yacht club with the best combined participation and overall high point score. High point calculation will include only the top five finishes per fleet in all classes and races.
- 7. LUNCHES**
Bag lunches will be available for purchase for \$8.00 during online registration. Lunches will include water, sandwich, chips, fruit, and dessert.
- 8. DISCLAIMER**
Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
