Advocacy is one of the most important services NAEA provides for its members. Nine years ago, we added an important tool to our advocacy arsenal: A political action committee (PAC). We would like to take a moment of your time today to share with you why the PAC is important.

Our PAC exists to help elect federal candidates who support effective tax administration and policies that are favorable towards enrolled agents. The PAC is non-partisan and is committed to helping support legislators on both sides of the aisle. NAEA PAC supports, for the most part, members of the Senate Finance Committee and the House Ways and Means Committee. These committees have jurisdiction over federal tax policy. NAEA's non-partisan PAC recognizes today's tax policy leaders and looks forward to tomorrow's tax policy leaders. The PAC augments our other efforts to partner with legislators who are taking on and advancing the important issues that enrolled agents face daily.

NAEA PAC is administered by NAEA staff; its operations are overseen by the PAC Steering Committee. The Steering Committee is made up of five NAEA members appointed by the association's president. Disbursements to candidates are made based on a stringent set of criteria and must be approved by the Steering Committee. \$500 to \$999	President's Club
\$250 to \$499	Board of Directors' Club
\$100 to \$249	Committee Chair's Club

NAEA PAC is a multi-candidate political action committee that helps elect federal candidates who support effective tax administration and policies favorable to enrolled agents. Contributions to NAEA PAC are voluntary and are not deductible from federal taxes. All contributions must be drawn from personal accounts and must not exceed \$5,000 per calendar year.
