What is the APALA Lifetime Warrior Program?

The APALA Lifetime Warrior Program was launched to recognize the commitment of APALA Warriors – those that have dedicated their lives to advance Asian Pacific American worker, immigrant and civil rights. APALA Lifetime Warriors will be celebrated and honored for your contributions to fight for social and economic justice.

By becoming an APALA Lifetime Warrior, you are able to support the following APALA program areas:



ORGANIZING INSTITUTE

A recent report produced by the Center for Economic and Policy Research found that Asian Pacific Americans comprise the fastest growing segment of the unionized workforce. Part of this growth can be attributed to APALA's commitment to train the next generation of Asian Pacific American union organizers. The APALA Organizing Institute is an intensive three-day training that provides Asian Pacific American young workers, as well as rank and file members, the skills to become effective union organizers.

EVERY VOTE COUNTS

Asian Pacific American voters have the potential to become a critical swing vote in countless elections across the country. Unfortunately, mainstream political parties and candidates oftentimes overlook Asian Pacific American voters. As a result, APALA initiated Every Vote Counts, a political program designed to engage and activate infrequent Asian Pacific American voters through voter registration, voter education, voter mobilization, and voter protection.



LABOR AND COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

APALA serves as a bridge to connect the Asian Pacific American community with the broader labor movement. This is achieved through support of local struggles, as well as national campaigns to advocate for pro-worker legislation. The First National Asian Pacific American Workers' Rights Hearing, the APALA Young Worker Initiative and the APALA Congressional Voter Guide comprise three pillars of this bridge.

How Lifetime Warriors Will Help Build APALA

\$5,000 would cover the costs to conduct a two-week phonebank operation to contact close to 1,000 infrequent Asian Pacific American voters.

\$2,500 would cover the costs to organize a local workers' rights hearing to provide a platform to empower immigrant workers.

\$1,000 would cover the cost to design, print, and mail 1,500 candidate and issue comparison postcards in English, Chinese, Korean, and Vietnamese.

\$500 would cover the cost to sponsor a young worker or college student to attend the APALA three-day Organizing Institute.

\$250 would cover the cost to sponsor a young worker or college student to attend the APALA Convention.

\$100 would cover the cost to produce 20 APALA Congressional Voters Guides, which track legislation related to worker, immigrant, and civil rights.
