

## **2014 On-going Study/Commissions**

NHSENATE BILL 315 - Establishing a board of building officials.  
This bill establishes the board of building officials for the certification and regulation of persons enforcing the state building code and conducting building inspections.

NHSENATE BILL 335 - Establishing a commission to study career and technical education centers.

The commission shall study career and technical education, and make recommendations concerning:

- (a) Tax credit programs for donations of equipment and funding for the cost of apprenticeship and training programs offered by a regional vocational center, including the compensation of employees in direct supervision and training of students in a vocational education center program;
- (b) Funding for construction and renovation programs; and
- (c) Increasing partnerships between businesses, skilled trades, advanced manufacturing, and CTE programs.
