About Tree Farm Field Day

The American Tree Farm System (ATFS) is a nationwide program that encourages private forest owners to actively manage their forests in a sustainable manner for multiple values. Launched in 1941, ATFS is the world's oldest sustainable forest and certification program. The system is managed by the American Forest Foundation and supported by 46 Tree Farm Committees with over 4,000 volunteer foresters.

Today, approximately 95,000 Tree Farmers manage 26 million acres of privately owned forestland nationwide and more than 1,450 N.H. Tree Farmers manage 500,000 acres of forestland in the Granite State. These landowners proudly display the familiar green and white Tree Farm sign signifying they are a part of the Tree Farm System. In recognition of the efforts made by New Hampshire landowners who care about the management of our forests, the New Hampshire Tree Farm committee awards one outstanding Tree Farm the honor of the Outstanding Tree Farm of the Year.
