2014-2015 Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 pack of 24 regular crayons (Crayola preferred)
- 12 glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)
- 1 bottle school glue (4 oz., Elmer's, washable)
- 1 pack of colored pencils, 12 count (Crayola preferred)
- 2 erasers (pink, bevel, latex-free)
- 2 packs of fat felt-tipped markers, 8 count (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pack of thin felt-tipped markers, 8 count (Crayola preferred)
- 2 low-odor dry erase markers (Black, fine tip, Expo preferred)
- 1 set of watercolors w/brush
- 2 pocket folders (any color)
- 1 package of clear sheet protectors
- 1 white board (double-sided, 9"x12", basic skills)
- 1 package of construction paper – 12"x18" size or larger (any color)
- 1 package of tissue paper (white or mixed colors)
- 1 ream of white multipurpose copy paper, 8.5" x 11"
- 1-3-ring binder – 1 1/2" ring (any color)
- 2 boxes of tissues (unscented, no lotion)
- 1 canister of wet wipes (Seventh Generation/other non-toxic or unscented brand preferred)
- 1 sandwich size plastic snack container (to bring home small projects that would crush in a plastic bag – Ziploc brand is great!) – **Please label with child's name.**
- 1 water bottle with leak-proof closure – **Please label with child's name.**
- 1 long-sleeved shirt for art class - **Please label with child's name.**
- 1 extra set of clothes (appropriate for season, in case of accidents)
 - Please put items in a gallon size, resealable bag **with name on the outside.**
- 1 pair of gym shoes & small carrying bag (Velcro closure shoes, unless child is able to tie his/her own shoes) – **Please put your child's name on their gym shoes.**
- 1 pair of rubber bottomed "Hausschuhe" - These are indoor only shoes or slippers to be worn in the classroom. Students change into these shoes when they arrive at school and they will be kept at school. No flip-flops are allowed.
- A pillow and blanket for nap time!

NOTE: The tennis shoes specified for gym can also be used as classroom shoes. The shoes used for gym and/or the classroom cannot be worn for outdoor activities during recess. In general, shoes worn to school should accommodate running activities outside. Gym shoes and Hausschuhe may NOT be worn outside!!

Suggested Donations

Below is a list of items that are not required yet would be extremely helpful during the upcoming school year. Please do not feel obligated to purchase any of these items, however, any help is greatly appreciated!

Clothes and/or accessories (for dress up and role plays)
Low-odor dry erase markers/crayons
Marbles or stones
Old magazines (for art projects)
Tempera or water color paint
Beads or gemstones
Pipecleaners / chenille stems
Pasta, beans, etc. (for math and art projects)
Pompoms
Feathers
Felt
Air-dry or polymer clay
Any extra scrap fabric
Q-tips and cotton balls
Ribbon
Yarn/wool/string
Wax paper
Clear contact paper
Cool things from nature (acorns, pine cones, seeds and seed pods, etc.)
