Items to be labeled with first and last name:

2 white three-ring binders: one with a 2" ring, one with a 3" ring. both with inside pocket & clear pocket on outside front (to insert a full size piece of paper)

1 red plastic pocket folders with prongs (homework folder)

1 mechanical pencil with extra lead

1 blue ink fountain pen (or roller ball)

1 wide-ruled notebook, any color (70-80 pages, NOT multi-subject)

1 backpack, large enough to carry a 9"x12" folder

1 lunch box/bag (recommended: insulated and/or with ice pack) if not getting hot lunch

1 small, reusable container for daily snack (separate from lunch box)

1 water bottle with leak-proof closure

1 paint shirt (used/worn long-sleeved shirt) labeled with name

1 pair of tennis shoes with rubber soles that fasten firmly around the ankle

(These shoes are for gym and will be kept at school.)

1 breathable bag to keep the gym shoes in 1 pair of rubber bottomed "Hausschuhe" *These are indoor only shoes or slippers to be worn in the classroom. Students change into these shoes when they arrive at school and they will be kept at school. No flip-flops are allowed.

NOTE: The tennis shoes specified for gym can also be used as classroom shoes. The shoes used for gym and/or the classroom cannot be worn for outdoor activities during recess. In general, shoes worn to school should accommodate running activities outside. Gym shoes and Hausschuhe may NOT be worn outside!!

Items NOT to be labeled: *These items will be used by the entire classroom community.

24 pencils (not mechanical pencils and prefer Ticonderoga brand)

1 pack Crayola markers, washable, thin

4 large pink (only pink) erasers

1 roll Scotch tape

1 pack of lined loose leaf paper

1 pack of squared loose leaf paper

1 box of disinfectant wipes (Aldi has the best price on those)
