Third Grade Teachers

Things to be labeled with your child's name

- 20 pencils
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 2 erasers
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener (small)
- 1 ruler (length of a pencil to fit into the pencil case)
- 3 composition notebooks (no spiral or glued binding!!)
- 1 take-home folder with two pockets
- 1 water bottle
- 1 pair of gym shoes (these can be used as house shoes)
- 1 pair of rubber bottomed house shoes (unless the gym shoes are used as such)
- 1 art/paint shirt
- 1 backpack (large enough to hold folders, lunch bag etc.)

Things to be shared with the classroom community

- 1 pack of Crayola colored pencils
- 1 pack of markers
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 4 Elmer's white glue sticks
- 3 Kleenex boxes

ENGLISH Class with Frau Wallace

Students will be expected to keep and carry stocked pencil bags to/from English class. They may use items they brought from the homeroom class to fill their pencil case. In the event that a student doesn't have their materials for class, the English room will have loaners.

Things to be labeled with your child's name
