Everything You Need to Know:

Tickets are on sale now to midnight (end of day) on Friday, October 3, or until sold out. \$8 for adults, \$5 for adults competing in the cook-off, \$5 for kids ages 5 and up, free for kids under age 5.

This event sells out due to the venue's limited capacity, so be sure to purchase your tickets early!

The cook-off has three categories: German Traditional (Auflauf), American Traditional, and International.

Can't stand the heat? Then stay out of the kitchen! You do not need to enter the competition to attend. After the judges are served, everyone will have a chance to eat. **The Kids' Buffet will be open at 6:00 pm. Kids can eat right away, so they can go play.**

Kids 12 and under can burn off steam in the *Adventure Zone* play area. All children **must wear socks** in the play area. Yes, there will be adult supervisors provided; however, a parent or guardian must supervise children under age 5.

So you can stand the heat of the kitchen, but not the competition? Bring your favorite dish for the *Competitive-Free Casseroles* or a sweet treat for the *Non-Judgmental Dessert Buffet*. Kid-friendly dishes are also welcome for the *Kids' Buffet*. Please sign up through VolunteerSpot here.

The PTO will supply water, cider, coffee, and edible table décor (apples and pretzels).

The Auflauf Cook-Off will be Zero Waste! All food waste and serving ware will be composted. Please try to compost and recycle as you prepare your competition entry! Many thanks to the Eastside Food Co-op for allowing us to use their commercial composting facility.

Please bring a non-perishable food item to donate to the Salvation Army's food shelf. We will have a collection bin at the event.

Everything Competitors Need to Know:

Purchase tickets for yourself and guests by completing the <u>registration form</u>.

Indicate on the form the category or categories in which you intend to compete: German Traditional (Auflauf); American Traditional (think tater tots and cream of mushroom soup); International (Mexican, Brazilian, Moroccan, Indian, Thai, Russian, Italian, etc.).

Because space is limited, please do not register for the competition unless you are sure that you can enter a dish.

On the day of the Cook-Off, please deliver your entry **no later than 5:45 p.m.** *Your dish should be completely cooked, hot, and ready to serve.* You will receive your competition number(s) at check-in.

The facility has limited oven space to warm up dishes, which will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis starting at 5:00 p.m. (We recommend bringing your dish hot and ready to serve.)

Judging begins promptly at 5:50 p.m. Entries delivered after 5:45 p.m. may be excluded from formal competition.

Once you have dropped off your dish for judging, join the festivities and enjoy all the great contest entries.
