Totus Tuus

The Totus Tuus parish summer catechetical program, a week-long “parish mission” for Catholic youth in the 1st through 12th grades, is dedicated to proclamation of the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through evangelization, catechesis, apologetics, Christian witness, the sacraments, Marian devotion, and Eucharistic worship. Totus Tuus, a Latin phrase meaning “totally yours,” was the motto of the late, great Pope John Paul II. Totus Tuus accomplishes this by taking college students and seminarians to engage the youth of the parish with skits, songs, games and inspiring, interactive teaching. Totus Tuus instructs young people in the basic tenets of the Catholic faith to cultivate both a firm intellectual grounding and a solid personal relationship with Christ. Totus Tuus demonstrates that one can be faithful, practicing Catholic and still have fun!

The Totus Tuus program has divided the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church into a six year cycle. In 2014, Totus Tuus will cover the 10 Commandments and the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary

The camp will also incorporate basic concepts of Computer Science with simple code instruction. Students will align ideas with exhibits at the Museum of Science and Industry that week as well!
