

## **Positive System- Benny's Best**



In conjunction with 'Paws' positive behavior incentives and our P.B.I.S. matrix of common behavior expectations (remember the passports from the December teach days) for all of K-5, we are adding "Benny's Best" to highlight individual students. This K-5 initiative is to promote positive behavior, create leadership skills, and highlight students that shine within a classroom. We plan to start using "Benny's Best" for March, April, and May/June.

Here's how it works: Students work to follow the school rules of being respectful, responsible, safe and ready. A "Benny's Best" recognition can go to a student that that: 1) goes above and beyond, or 2) shows consistent excellent behavior, or 3) shows impressive growth in a situation.

Each week classroom teacher in K-5 selects one student from their class that has gone above in the classroom and has shown their "Benny's Best." At the end of the week, Mrs. Feely will acknowledge the 22 students that earned a "Benny's Best" by reading their names over the PA system, and taking a group photo for the bulletin board. The names will be printed in the BUZZ as well.

At the end of the month, one student that earned a "Benny' Best" during the month will be chosen in a raffle. The winner will earn a small prize. The winner will also have their picture taken with the Bengal stuffed animal and placed on bulletin board.
