PORTH HIGHLIGHTS

Cologne



Most famous for its cathedral, there are 2,000 years of history in Cologne, and visitors here will find everything from Roman towers to Gothic churches to fine examples of modern architecture. Bonn

The birth place of Ludwig Beethoven, Bonn was the capital of the former West Germany. Since German Unification, it still plays a major role in German cultural events and has a rich university life.

Koblenz
