

Senior Prom Information

Date: Thursday, May 22, 2014 from 7 p.m. to midnight
Place: The Vanderbilt at South Beach, Staten Island, New York
Toast off: 5:00 P.M. at Marist High School; all parents are invited

- The first prom payment of \$75.00 per person must be paid by the first week of February to the Finance Office. The student should give the “reservation card” to Mr. Pratkanis. **No prom payment will be accepted if there is a past due balance on the tuition account.**
- The 2nd prom payment of \$60.00 per person is due the first week of May. Give “paid in full” card to Mr. Pratkanis. **No prom payment will be accepted if there is a past due balance on the tuition account.**
- The first payment is taken as a commitment to attend the prom. After that payment is made, that payment and all future payments are non-refundable.
- A student may add a guest up to May 15th. The Marist student’s 2 payments of \$75.00 and \$60.00 must have been paid before the guest is added.
- If you are paying by check write the check to Marist High School. In the subject line write “prom” along with the student’s last name.
- Students with outstanding financial obligations to the school at the time of the prom will not be permitted to attend **even if their prom payment has been made.**
- Dress Code: All students, including guests, are expected to dress appropriately and modestly for this formal event.
- Conduct: All rules of Marist High School will be in effect before, during and after the prom.
- Permission Slips: All students, including guests, must return a signed permission slip 10 days prior to the prom.
- Marist High School is not responsible for transportation to and from the prom.
