At only \$349 per credit, the Evening/Weekend Adult Learner Programs at Manor are convenient and affordable. The programs offer flexibility in scheduling with a variety of modalities including: traditional face to face, and hybrid classes in the late afternoon and evening, on-line classes, as well as, regular and accelerated Saturday morning classes.

The Adult Learning Programs at Manor College give you the opportunity to complete your associate degree in two years taking courses just in the evenings and on Saturdays. Exemption Testing, CLEP Testing and Portfolio Assessment are additional ways to earn credits toward your degree.

As a student in the Adult Learner Program you have many support services available to you including: academic advising, internet access to the library, an evening research librarian, free tutoring through the learning center, personal counseling, and transfer counseling to help you transition to the next step in realizing your educational goals.
