GENERAL RULES

Prom will be held from 7:00 pm - 11:00 pm on Saturday, May 10th, 2014

Once students arrive, they may not leave and be readmitted to the prom

In order to help save students money, we will provide a wrist corsage while taking photos

PLEASE DRIVE CAREFULLY TO AND AROUND JEROME SPEED LIMITS ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED

TRANSPORTATION VIA SCHOOL VAN
to and from the prom will be available for a limited number of students
All students using the van for transportation must travel
BOTH to AND from the prom on the van - NO EXCEPTIONS!

SIGN UP FOR TRANSPORTATION - FIRST COME FIRST SERVED

- Each PACE student is allowed to bring only one guest
- The guest must not be older than 20 years of age and must return a guest pass and photo ID that includes date of birth by no later than 3:00 pm, on Thursday, May 8th
- The same ID must be presented at the event in order to gain entrance
- Tickets must be brought to the event in order for both student and guest to be admitted
- Attendees will not be readmitted to Prom once they have left the building
- No tobacco or tobacco products are permitted
- No alcohol will be allowed on the premises. If students are suspected
 of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, they will not be
 permitted to attend or remain at the Prom
- There will be police presence at the Prom

From PACE Prescott Valley Campus via Hwy 17

Drive on AZ-69 South to AZ-169 North to I-17N to AZ-260 E in Camp Verde

- Once you Exit for AZ-260, get into the left lane, heading toward AZ 89A/Cottonwood
- At the light, take a left on AZ-260 toward Cottonwood
- At the intersection of AZ-260 and Hwy 89A, get into the left lane (Sizzler is on your Right)
- Take a left at the lights and follow toward the next intersection of Historic 89A and 89A bypass
- Safeway will be on your right. Get into the left hand turning lane.
- Turn left on 89A Bypass and continue to follow AZ-89A
- Follow AZ-89A toward Jerome, to each roundabout, continuing straight on 89A
- At the last roundabout (5th), follow around toward Jerome
- Follow to the town of Jerome -

From PACE Prescott Valley via 89A over Mingus Mt.

From AZ-69, take Glassford Hill Road

- · As you approach AZ-89A, follow toward Cottonwood
- Stay on AZ-89A, through the switchbacks, toward Jerome
- Follow to the town of Jerome -

CAREFULLY FOLLOW THE SPEED LIMIT - VERY STRICTLY ENFORCED

- As you continue into Jerome, you'll see the Fire Department, where there is a sharp right turn
- Follow through the town of Jerome past Grapes Restaurant, the Police Dept., and as you approach a Y, stay to the left
- You'll see the Flatiron Grill on your left where you'll make an ACUTE left turn
- You'll be facing the Jerome Co-Op Gallery as you take that sharp left
- You'll pass the House of Joy on your right
- Shortly, you'll see a parking lot on your left and street parking on the right
- · Spook Hall is on your right, just after the small Chamber of Commerce building

From Camp Verde via Hwy 260

Drive on Finnie Flat Road, turning right on AZ-260


- Continue to follow AZ-260 W toward Cottonwood
- At the intersection of AZ-260 and Hwy 89A, get into the left lane (Sizzler is on your Right)
- Take a left at the lights and follow toward the next intersection of Historic 89A and 89A bypass
- Safeway will be on your right. Get into the left hand turning lane.
- Turn left on 89A Bypass and continue to follow AZ-89A
- Follow AZ-89A toward Jerome, to each roundabout, continuing straight on 89A
- At the last roundabout (5th), follow around toward Jerome
- Follow to the town of Jerome -

ONCE YOU APPROACH JEROME

From Prescott Valley, following 89A (over Mingus Mt.) - you'll follow a sharp right curve at the Fire Station. Continue, following past Grapes Restaurant, the Police Dept., Mile High Grill, and take a SHARP left at the Flatiron Grill (on your left). Drive a short distance, and you'll see street parking on your right, and a parking lot on your left. PROM location is on the right side of the street, after the Chamber of Commerce building.



From Prescott Valley (taking Hwy 17 to Rt.260 and

From Camp Verde, you'll come into Jerome, following 89A, and soon see the Jerome Co-Op Gallery on your right.

Drive a short distance, and you'll see street parking on your right, and a parking lot on your left. PROM location is on the right side of the street, after the Chamber of Commerce building.

GENERAL Dress Code

Attire for the prom is FORMAL/SEMI-FORMAL This means that appropriate attire is required for admittance, but is not a strictly 'black tie' event.

All attire (including shoes) must be worn throughout the entire event. Ties may be loosened, but not removed. NO Flip Flops or Slippers.

LADIES

- Dresses must be modestly cut in the front so as not to show too much cleavage; plunging necklines are not allowed
- Bra top type dresses are not acceptable. Two piece dresses are acceptable if they meet, and not show any midriff
- No see through tops or bra tops. All dresses must cover the midriff region and be modest in in style with no sheer fabric. Dresses may not utilize see-through fabrics such as (but not limited to) tulle, netting or 'illusion' below the bust line
- "Mesh" that attaches a bra top to a skirt bottom, attempting to make it a one piece dress will not be allowed.
- Strapless dresses, dresses with spaghetti straps or halter top dresses that meet the requirements listed in these guidelines are APPROVED dresses
- Dresses may not be shorter than THREE INCHES above the knee or have a slit that is any higher than THREE INCHES above the knee AND must NOT ride up when dancing

No pinning will be allowed as an alteration to a dress if without the pins the dress does not meet the dress code. Fabric inserts must be sewn-in as alterations to the dress. No cover-ups (shawls/wraps, sweaters, coats) will be allowed over dresses that do not meet the dress code. Undergarments should NOT be visible.

GENTLEMEN

- Dress suit or sport coat and tie or tuxedo. Sweatshirts, T-shirts or jeans are not permitted
- Appropriate footwear must be worn: Sneakers/tennis shoes ARE permitted, but must be clean and free from holes
- Non-formal headwear (baseball caps, do rags, bandanas, etc) will not be allowed Formal dress hats that go with a tuxedo, sport coat or suit are acceptable

If you are unsure about appropriate attire please ask one of the staff and they will be glad to help you. While we will be reasonable in our interpretation of these guidelines, students in violation of these guidelines will not be allowed to enter the prom. If students are turned away at the door, no refund for tickets will be given.
