

Be in the KNOW for Students and Parents!

EDMODO:

This is a great tool that teachers and our counseling staff utilize. It is similar to Facebook in that it is based around communities/groups. If a teacher utilizes they will have a code to give to the students that identifies that community/group. The counseling office posts announcements and scholarship information to their group. In order to receive the information or be a part of the group you must first create a STUDENT ACCOUNT.

A student only ever needs one account for their entire high school career because they can add more groups all they need is that group's code. You must have at least one code in order to set up the student account initially. ***CHS-counseling code is e8fwbe***. If you already have an account you just use our code to add us!

In order to set up a parent account, you must have the parent code off of your son/daughters account which they have to be logged in to get; it will be on the left hand side. Then you can create a parent account and have multiple children on the same account. You must use different e-mails. Multiple parents can also have different accounts with the same children.

Note: this must initially be set up via a computer. Once the account is active you can add the app on your phone, i-pad etc...

STUDENT VUE/PARENT VUE

This is the best way to view your grades, assignments and attendance marks on a daily basis. The phone app makes it simple as can be. You can access parent and teacher vue at www.fusd1.org/chs on the right hand side. You will see grade and attendance drop down menu.

As a student, use your student ID and the password you use to get on computers at school. If you have not turned in your internet user agreement you will not be able to access this until you do so.

Parents, you will need an activation code which you can get from lhammit@fusd1.org in order to get your parent vue account set up or you can use your son or daughters account as well.
