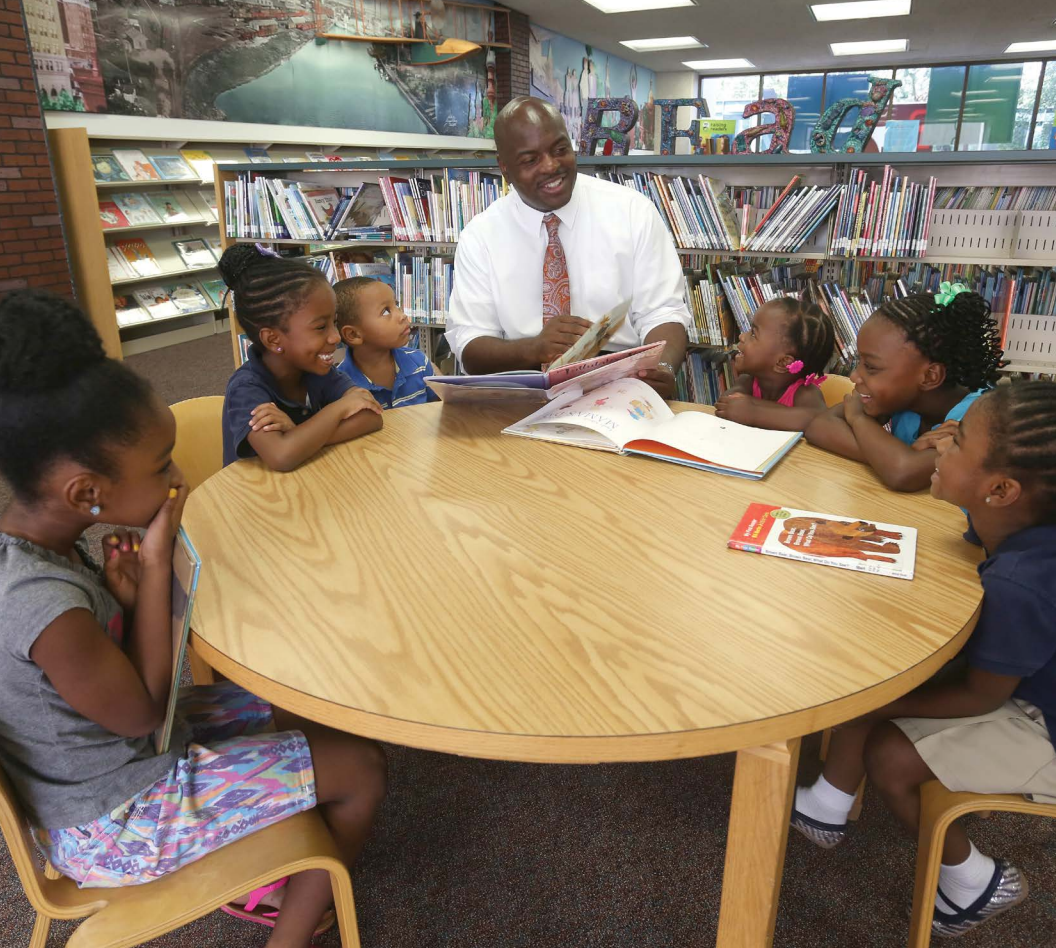

Jobs & Economic Opportunity

- Work with local unions, trade associations, and community colleges to expand job-training programs to give workers of all ages the skills to get a job and bring businesses here.

- Create a small and minority business “one-stop shop” to help them qualify for city, county, and state government contracts.
- Host annual community job-fairs to match employers with candidates in our neighborhood.





Education & Schools

As a product of public schools and married to a public school teacher, **Ed Narain is a firm believer in the value of public education.** Narain will stand up for our public schools and make sure that Republicans like Rick Scott don't punish our children and schools just for political reasons.
