The 27th edition of Canadian Tourism Commission's annual Canada Media Marketplace was held in San Francisco this year. Taking place over two days, the marketplace consists of one solid day of meetings and one day of industry panels, briefings by Destination BC and the CTC and networking events.

The Tartan Group, represented by Kate Rogers and Dana Cohen conducted 44 sit down meetings during the rapid 15 minute rotational format and secured 6 additional meetings through open marketplace and separately arranged meetings.
