- Applications must include completed and signed application, payment by check and proof of insurance for food vendors. Applications are subject to the approval of the RTW 4 CASA committee. Vendor registrations are non-refundable.
- Application deadline is September 1, 2014.
- Vendors will be notified of their acceptance after receiving your completed application and once reviewed. Your space will be pre-assigned.
- Set-up on the day of the event can begin the day prior or the morning of. Vendors should be completely set up by 9:00 a.m.
- You are responsible for cleaning up your area after the event.
- The vendor fee is \$50 and should be made to CASA of NH by check
