Kids Helping Kids Program

This program will offer your children or grandchildren the unique opportunity to learn about charity and compassion on a personal level. They will get to know the families at Rainbow Village to help them realize that kids they may be sitting next to in the classroom may be leaving school to deal with real-world problems every night if it weren't for the generosity of their support. There is no better way to get your kids involved in the community, helping others, and philanthropy.

How it works

- 1. You will sit down as a family to discuss this wonderful opportunity. Rainbow Village will provide you with the information you need to outline the program for your children or grandchildren.
- 2. Once your children or grandchildren are on board, you can choose to have them participate in one of two ways.
 - The first way is to ask them to donate a portion of their hard earned allowance each month to Rainbow Village. To encourage greater impact, you can tell them you will match dollar for dollar everything they donate. The more they donate, the more you match, the greater the impact.
 - You set aside a portion of your annual charitable dollars for the kids to donate to Rainbow Village. You challenge your kids to match that donation throughout the year by saving money to donate to the charity.
- 3. Once the amount is determined for each child, you will sign your child up to make the donation on a monthly basis. The donation will be made directly from your credit card or check, but the acknowledgement will be sent to them. They will quickly learn their generosity goes a long way.
- 4. Your children / grandchildren will receive a quarterly newsletter informing them about the ways their donation is changing the lives of these kids.
- 5. Once a year, your children/grandchildren will receive a thank you letter from one of the kids in the program letting them know how their gift directly impacted them.
- 6. When families graduate from the program, your child will be informed of their success and their new found independence.
- 7. Once a year, we will try to get all of the kid donors (and kids in the program) together for a group picture. We will display those pictures on campus for to commemorate their support and generosity for the program.
