Every mental health and developmental diagnosis has associated problems with executive functioning. These executive functioning deficits are often at the root of underperformance, making it so much harder for our children to function in school, family, and social relationships. Dr. McCloskey provides a high-energy presentation with engaging case illustrations of deficits in executive functioning. This intermediate level training will elucidate the elements of executive functioning, including the 33 self-regulatory executive functions, and provide an overview of strategies to build these capacities in children and families.
