Next Steps

Following the Early Childhood Information Evening:

1. Complete Application

This is our opportunity to get to know you and your child. Please answer every question and feel free to add a narrative if you would like to tell us more. Please use dark ink and print clearly. Don't forget to attach a photo of your child/family. It helps us to remember everyone!

2. Submit \$75 Fee

You can submit the application and fee to the Director of Admissions in several ways: By mail; hand delivery; or by email to ltimmons@waldorfschool.com

3. Full Class

If a class is full, your application will be placed on file to be contacted when a space becomes available. A new application must be completed for each academic year. Applications will not automatically be carried forward.

4. Space Availability

If there is space available in your class, your application will be forwarded to the Early Childhood faculty for review.

5. Family Conversation

If agreed, the applicant and parents are invited to a Family Conversation with the two class teachers. These take place in the classroom and are scheduled by the Admissions Director. Both parents, along with their child, are expected to attend.

6. Class Visit

If it is agreed to be beneficial, the student may be invited to visit the class for one to five days.

7. Notification

Notification of status will be sent in writing to the applicant

8. Registration

If an invitation has been extended, a student must complete registration before entering the class.
