The Jordan River Commission (JRC) is a voluntary partnership of local governments and community organizations working together to increase environmental, economic, cultural, and recreational value of the Jordan River corridor. The JRC is currently working on an interactive, educational, mobile website for the river corridor, with the assistance of an Urban Waters grant from the EPA. Using smartphone technology and a series of interpretive stops, we are turning the Jordan River Parkway Trail into a nature center without walls. With this new tool, trail users will be able to learn about the Jordan River's history, ecology, and water, and about the role that individuals can play in restoring and improving the quality of the corridor. Content for the interpretive website is being developed by community members and high school students in the west side of Salt Lake City, and by the general public at large.
