- ➤ <u>Important Note:</u> Mr. Dybzinski is devoting an entire session each half of the summer (Sessions 1 and 3 below) to be focused on four-level grammar analysis. Some students (new or returning to Liberty) find the level of grammatical rigor at Liberty hard to manage. This session will be ideal preparation for the beginning of the year grammar launch in each of the English classes. The other two sessions (2 and 4) are grade specific, covering a variety of English skills.
