



Music Takes Center Stage in June at Sarah Chudnow Community

MEQUON, WI– The Summer Concert series kicks-off Wednesday, June 11 at 7 pm with Milwaukee's own Frogwater. John (vocals, acoustic guitar, banjo, mandolin) & Susan Nicholson (vocals, viola, mandolin) bring a mix of Celtic, American, old-time, bluegrass, Cajun and blues music for their high energy show. Their innovative interpretations of traditional tunes span the centuries and the miles and defy categorization.

The series continues when L'il Rev takes the stage on Wednesday, June 25 at 7 pm. His musical repertoire includes old-time blues, Tin Pan Alley music, Yiddish and American folksong. While L'il Rev is well known for his ukulele and harmonica stylings, he is also a seasoned multi-instrumentalist, equally adept at old time banjo, flat-pick guitar and blues mandolin.

In addition to the Summer Concert Series, there are a variety of musical acts to check out. Bob Ropiak - a singer, musician and storyteller - will perform "toe-tappin' favorites" as a one-man-band on Sunday, June 1 at 2pm. Ropiak's motto, as proclaimed on his online personal profile, is, "Out to change the world, one toe at a time."

On Sunday, June 8 at 2 pm, Sarah Chudnow favorite Terry Morganroth returns to sing the hits of the 40s, 50s and 60s.

Why not take Dad to see a concert on Father's Day? On Sunday, June 15 at 2 pm, Papi Makeana performs traditional, contemporary and classic pop tunes, as well as audience requests.

On Sunday, June 22 at 2 pm enjoy a musical performance by Festival European Musical Group. The group will entertain residents and guests with authentic old world guitar and accordion music.
