

Music City Circuit

The Music City Circuit provides general downtown options for those who want to venture out Friday and Saturday during free time. The Music City Circuit provides **free** service to many downtown destinations including Bridgestone Arena, Schermerhorn Symphony Center, Ryman Auditorium, Tennessee Performing Arts Center (TPAC), Farmers' Market, Country Music Hall of Fame, Historic Second Avenue, Frist Center for the Visual Arts, Bicentennial Mall, Gulch bars and restaurants, the Richard H. Fulton Complex, downtown hotels and other downtown attractions and landmarks. Buses and vans stop at more than 75 locations along the three routes, including many of the destinations listed above.

There are three routes:

- The Blue Circuit
 - On weekdays buses run every 30 minutes from 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 am. Buses run every 15 minutes from 11:00 am to 6:00 pm.
 - On Saturdays buses run every 15 minutes from 11 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The Green Circuit
 - On weekdays buses run every 30 minutes from 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 am. Buses run every 15 minutes from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
 - On Saturdays buses run every 15 minutes from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- The Purple Circuit
 - On weekdays buses run every 15 minutes from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
 - There are no Saturday routes on the Purple Circuit
