Malcolm Archer is Director of Chapel Music at Winchester College, where he trains and conducts the Quiristers and Chapel Choir and teaches organ in the College. He is much in demand as a choir trainer and choral and orchestral conductor, and has directed concerts, workshops and courses in various parts of the globe, as well as working with several leading orchestras.

He has enjoyed a distinguished career in cathedral music, which has taken him to posts at Norwich, Bristol, Wells Cathedrals and then Director of Music at St. Paul's Cathedral in London. During his time there he directed the choir for several State services, including the 80th Birthday Service for HM The Queen, for which he was invited by Buckingham Palace to compose a special anthem, performed live on BBC1.

His many broadcasts and recordings from Wells and St. Paul's have received critical acclaim, and his CD of Christmas music from St. Paul's was voted Editor's number one choice in The Daily Telegraph. Malcolm is also the Musical Director of the Jean Langlais Festival in France. As an organ recitalist he has played in nine European countries, the USA and Canada, and his CDs include repertoire as diverse as J.S.
