FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

So what's this all about?

This is perhaps the most fun you will ever have! You start as a tidy clean being; as you pass through the color zones, you will be blasted with different colors at each station. By the time we are done, it will appear as if our students have been dipped in a rainbow! Prepare for the time of your life!

What's going to happen?

Here's where the fun begins! Everyone is encouraged to wear as much white as possible. Feel free to purchase our logo t-shirts, tutus, sweatband, or whatever as long as it's FUN and mostly white! Next, we are going to blaze you in color; Color Zones are located around the running track. That's right, we are going to turn our students into tie-dyed works of art!

What are you blazing our students with?

The color powder is 100% edible, biodegradable, and FDA approved, so no worries! It can be eaten, although we don't recommend it! The FPA will be providing all of students with sunglasses for the run and baby wipes to them wipe down.

Will the color ruin clothes or running shoes?

The "color" does mostly wash out after the event. As with anything dirty, the sooner you wash the better. We suggest wearing items that you wouldn't mind getting colorful. If you would like to preserve the color, please see the next question. If you wash the shirt....the color will eventually come out.

How do I keep the color in the shirt?

Your best bet is to never wash it and let the stink permeate through your house for decades. If that doesn't work for you, try the following suggestions, but be warned, they may end up ruining your masterpiece of a shirt: 1) Use spray adhesive post-race and let it dry before washing or 2) spray your shirt with vinegar, then iron it before washing.
