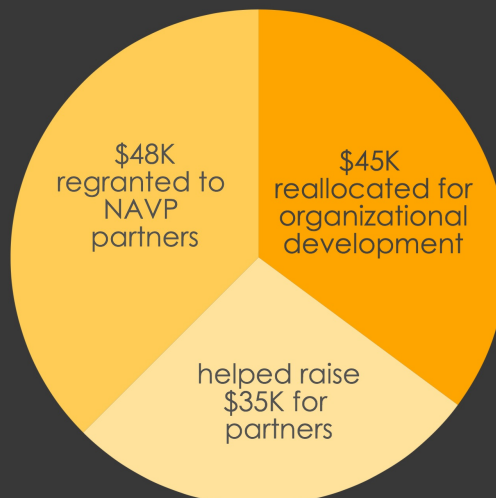
Newly Naturalized Voters



May Special Election: The Healthy Kids, Healthy Teeth, Portland's water fluoridation campaign served as a formative experience for OV and many community groups of color who were participating in an electoral campaign for the first time. Despite the disappointing loss, we gained critical experience, built new capacities, and succeeded in having over 10,000 GOTV conversations with members of the RAE. We also gained two key partners through this campaign: Native American Youth and Family Center and Latino Network who are building their 2014 civic engagement plans through CAP and are gearing up for their next ballot measure campaign.
