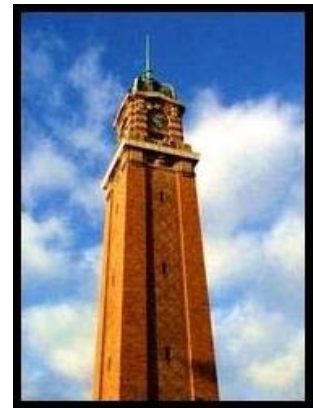
HISTORIC RESOURCES COMMITTEE
