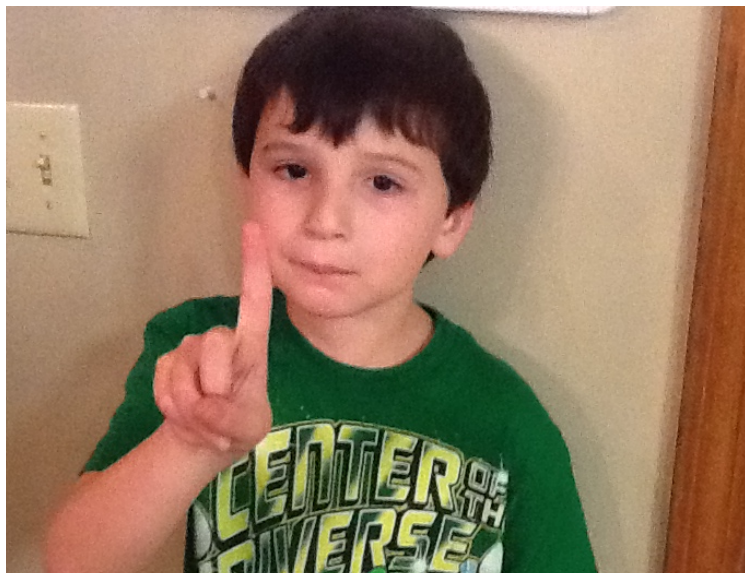


Autism Awareness Month
