



# Adopt-A-GPA PROGRAM

## Levels of Participation

1. Pick up trash and rubble on the area once during the month of May. A second pick-up in August before the hunting season would also be helpful, but not required.
2. Repair fences, broken wires, fence posts, and gates.
3. Assist GF&P staff with habitat improvement projects as needed.
4. Propose and implement habitat and maintenance improvement projects reviewed by GF&P staff.
