Adopt-A-Team 7.0 SKB Fundraising Program Q&A

What types of shooting sports groups are eligible for the Adopt-A-Team 7.0 Fundraising Program?

The Adopt-A-Team Fundraising 7.0 Program is available to shooting teams (high school and collegiate) or FFA Shooting Sports Programs. Some Youth Shooting Clubs may also qualify. *Please call John Linquist for more details.*

What is the Shooting Trust (ST)?

The ST Fund is an endowment that provides financial support to high school and collegiate shooting sports programs by providing grants based on the balance of individual program accounts.

How does our team gain access to our shooting trust and how much will we get each year?

Grants from the trust are available to any shooting sports program that has a balance in their ST Fund. You may request a grant for a maximum of 5% of the fund balance. The goal is to provide permanent financial support for the shooting program. Visit www.scholasticshootingtrust.org for more information.

What happens to the shooting trust if our local shooting team or club falls apart?

ST funds are owned by the MidwayUSA Foundation and are non-refundable. If a shooting team ceases to exist, the fund will remain in their name for a period of three years in case it is restarted. After that time the fund will need to be moved to another team of your choice or it will be redistributed to an adjacent scholastic shooting sports program.

Can multiple teams and/or shooting clubs partner in a joint fundraising effort?

Yes! If meeting the fundraising goal of the respective firearms package is a challenge for one shooting program, we recommend you partner with another local shooting program and share the benefits.

When does the fundraising effort have to be completed?

Participating chapters and shooting sports programs commit to submitting the minimum goal (\$2,000/\$1,000) for establishing their scholastic shooting trust by November 30, 2014 for a 3:1 match. If your group would like to continue to fundraise after meeting the goal, you can continue to sell tickets for a longer period of time.

Who is responsible for permits and gambling regulations?

Participating Chapters & ticket sellers (clubs or teams) are responsible to abide by & comply with all local or state gambling laws and regulations.
