

Effective July 1, 2014, chapters will need to pay \$10, instead of \$5, for a Ringnecks or Whistlers membership.

The chapter cost of youth memberships has not increased in more than 10 years and the increase is needed to cover the current costs of the magazine.

YOUTH MEMBERSHIP FACTS

- PF/QF has almost 18,000 youth members across the country
- Approximately 90% of youth memberships come from chapter events (i.e. banquets & youth events)
- It costs over \$8 to produce and process a youth membership
- The chapter youth membership cost has not changed in 10+ years
- Other conservation groups (DU & NWTF) charge \$10 for a youth membership

This increased membership rate will allow us to accomplish the following:

Forever Outdoors Magazine

- Continue to improve the design of the new Forever Outdoors magazine. The new Forever Outdoors publication now has a targeted age group of 13 – 17 years of age instead of 8 – 12
- Page count of the magazine has increased from 12 pages to 16 pages
- We want to increase page count and offer content electronically (this will put us in a better position to sell advertising)

Pheasants Forever & Quail Forever National Youth Services

- We have more youth programs to offer chapters than ever before (i.e. Ammo Grants, Adopt-A-Team Program, Young Guns and Pollinator Habitat Project Grants)
- We will continue to offer Focus on Forever trainings, providing opportunities for chapter volunteers to learn about our programs and gain ideas for chapter youth events
