Wallace, the first editor of Wallaces' Farmer magazine. There may even be time to browse through the gift shop featuring a diverse selection of items from artisans throughout southern lowa.
- Lunch at the Gathering Table Restaurant on the grounds will be a special treat. Chef Katie Routh is famous for building menus around the harvest from the farm and gardens and local farmers.
- After lunch, we'll make the short trip to Greenfield's wonderful old town square where we'll visit the <u>Warren Cultural Center</u>. This old opera house features the performance area, the gallery and Ed & Eva's gift shop.
- We'll have some free time on the town square and see the <u>Hotel</u> Greenfield renovated from the early days of the 20th century.
- We'll end our day at the <u>lowa Aviation Museum</u>, home of the lowa Aviation Hall of Fame. We'll see some beautiful, rare vintage planes from the first days of aviation to Vietnam War-era aircraft.
- Our last stop is the Freedom Rock just outside Greenfield.
