AMGA Certified Guide/Guest Guide Policy

- 1. Guest guides must be certified in the discipline they will guide.
- 2. Interested guides should contact Tyson Bradley or Julie Faure (uma@utahmountainadventures.com) to apply. All requests must include a brief resume (to include: number of years guiding, average number of guiding days per year over the past 3 years, a list of other companies you have worked for, completed training, and certifications), a copy of your AMGA certification, a copy of current WFR and CPR certification cards and your guiding plan (routes, dates, number of clients, etc. The guiding plan should be discussed with Tyson or Julie.)
- 3. Guest guides will be UMA employees for the duration of their accepted guiding plan.
- 4. All guest guides will be expected to read and sign an agreement stating that they will follow all UMA policies and procedures.
- 6. The Guest Guide's clients must make reservations through the UMA office (the office will be advised to expect a reservation once the guide's plan is accepted). Clients will be charged appropriate PRIVATE rates. Guest guides may charge add'l fees over and above this, if they so desire, collect from their clients, and pay UMA directly. UMA will pay the guest guide the stated wages for the activities completed. The guest guide will also be paid a 10% commission on the guiding income generated.
