#### **Seminar Content**

The term "justice" often implies righting things that are wrong, including lifting up those who have been knocked down. In many cases, though, "justice" has not been used not to lift up but to isolate (either by sending someone to a room—your room, the principal's office—or incarcerating in prison).

Is there a different way to think about justice? Can we move from a model of separation by incarceration and move towards restoration through faith?

If we think about accountability, could there be a way to be accountable and hold others accountable that goes beyond "an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth"?

New York City offers a unique venue to think about these issues and bring thoughts and questions. We'll discuss the following topics:

- 1. What Biblically-based alternatives could we use to resolve conflict?
- 2. How are we to live justly, especially when the term "justice" is often used in unjust ways?

#### **Expectations**

All participants are expected to:

- 1. Abide by the group's covenant of conduct.
- 2. Participate fully in ALL aspects of the program.
- 3. Try new food.
- 4. Bring comfortable shoes.
