The United Methodist Church needs new clergy now more than ever. A recent report indicated the need for 4,000 ordained elders by 2020 and an additional 5,000 by 2030. The "Called to BE" leadership conference will help high school and college students to consider their vocational calling to serve God and to prepare for the future. Participants will meet young adults living into their vocations in their churches and communities. The conference will include devotions, Bible studies, workshops, and worship led by young UM pastors and North Central College and Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary students. Highlights of the conference include campus tours of North Central College and Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary, visits to dynamic local churches, and sightseeing in Chicago.
