## Medicare Annual Enrollment Period October 15<sup>th</sup> through December 7<sup>th</sup> 2014

Whether you have original Medicare, a Medicare Advantage plan, or a Part D prescription drug plan, you have one opportunity each year to make changes. This opportunity is Medicare's annual enrollment period. Annual Enrollment begins October 15<sup>th</sup> and runs through December 7<sup>th</sup>. Changes made during this time will become effective January 1, 2015.

In the past year you may have changed medications or been diagnosed with a new medical condition. Either of those changes could mean that your current plan will no longer meet your needs. The cost of your Medicare plan might have changed too. This is the time for you to review coverage and cost of the current plan and make changes to protect your health and your budget.

You can also receive help locally by contacting your Health Information Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP) to speak to a certified benefits counselor by dialing (210) 477-3275. By calling a HICAP counselor you will receive free and impartial counseling to help you make your decision.
