WorkShare Program – Alternative to Layoffs Can Relieve MA Employers

According to page 31 of the newly published <u>Mass BizWorks guide</u> for businesses, the WorkShare Program, "allows workers in the entire company, a company department, or even a small unit within the company to share reduced work hours while also collecting unemployment insurance benefits to supplement their reduced wages. The reduction of hours can range between 10% and 60%. Most employers reduce to a 32 hour work week (a 20% reduction)."
