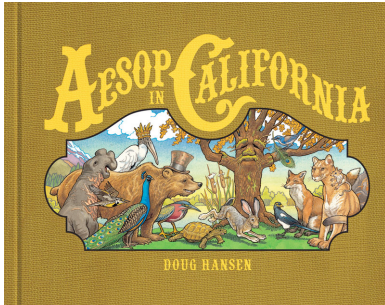

Aesop in California

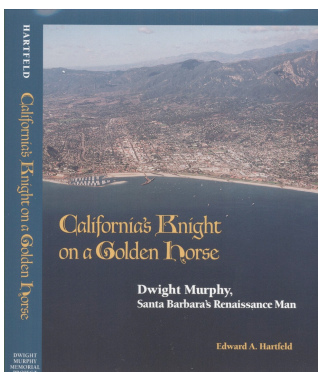
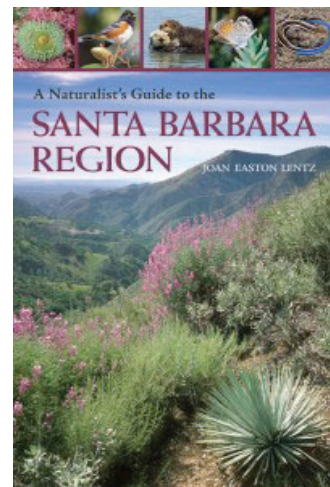
Doug Hansen
