- At no cost to the athlete



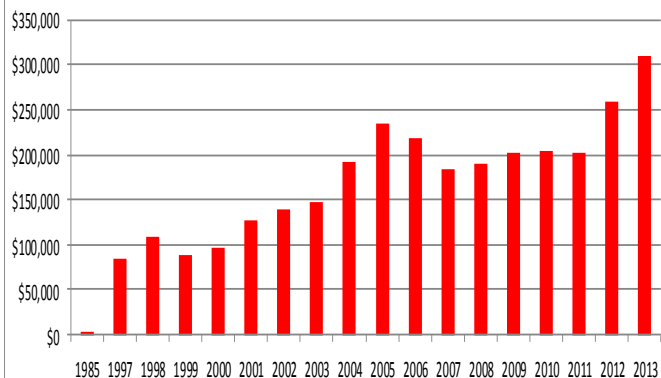
Law Enforcement Torch Run is...
