SELLING OF HAMETZ

If possible, all hametz – food not acceptable during Pesach (Passover), or materials containing such unacceptable food – should be destroyed or given away before the holiday begins. Should this be impossible, the hametz may be stored in such a way that we are sure not to use it during the holiday and its actual ownership is transferred to a non-Jew until the holiday ends.

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Mark Robbins to act on my behalf to sell all **hametz** possessed by me, knowingly or unknowingly, as defined by Torah and rabbinic law, and to lease all places wherein **hametz** owned may be found. This transaction will be in effect for the duration of the Passover holiday, which this year begins with sundown, April 14th, 2014, and concludes after nightfall, April 22, 2014.
