SELLING OF HAMETZ

If possible, all hametz – food not acceptable during Pesach (Passover), or materials containing such unacceptable food - should be destroyed or given away before the holiday begins. Should this be impossible, the hametz may be stored in such a way that we are sure not to use it during the holiday and its actual ownership is transferred to a non-Jew until the holiday ends.
