Current Work




As summer turns to autumn, our contractor is hard at work in several areas throughout the project. Old Broadway and West 125th Street (east of Broadway) have been paved and are pending new street trees this fall. Work has begun in the western part of the project area. Water main and catch basin drainage work has commenced in this area. The water main and drainage work being undertaken during this project is necessary because, in a city of 8.4 million people, what goes on below the street is just as important as what occurs above it. Water mains and other underground utilities need maintenance and replacement as much as worn out asphalt and cracked sidewalks. By doing them at the same time as the street level work, disruptions to the surrounding community are minimized.

Upcoming Work

Work on the Eastern end of the project will be complete once new street signs are installed and new trees are planted. Work on the western end of the project will continue for the coming months. We have updated our work zone (right) to reflect our move to the west and the water main work on the east side of Broadway. As always our current work areas are highlighted in orange and future work is in green. We look forward to future updates when we will add a third color to indicate completed work.
